

Terms of use & access information for electronic media

The Karlshochschule library offers a number of electronic media (databases, eJournals). Please consider the following regulations for use of the media:

Terms of Use

1. The use of the electronic media is only permissible within the framework of study, research and teaching.
2. The electronic content is only valid for private or scientific use and must not be distributed to third parties neither digitally nor in printed form.
3. Commercial use of the media is prohibited.
4. In addition to research and viewing on screens (depending on the database or platform provider), downloading, saving and printing part of the electronic media is allowed (e.g. single attachments and chapters)
5. A systematic download of the electronic media or a download of the complete database content is prohibited.
6. The provisions of copyright law apply.

Access information

Access on the campus network

Karlshochschule members have automatic access to all Library licensed content when they access the electronic content via the campus network (WLAN).

External users have the possibility to use the Research-PC on campus in the quiet zone of the library to access the electronic media (on request). For more information, please ask the Library Team.

Access from outside the campus network

Karlshochschule members can access the electronic offers from home as well. A VPN (Virtual Private Network) must be set up to connect them to the school network.
